EVENING SKATING PROGRAMS

CANSkate/KinderCANSkate: This learn to skate program offered for skater's that are 3+ years old. Ideal for siblings to skate together. It is coached by Professional Skate Canada coaches in a group lesson environment. Skaters will follow skill progression through stages/badges 1-6 as set out by Skate Canada programming. CSA approved hockey helmet and mittens are mandatory and a face mask is highly recommended.

CANSkate/PreSTARskate: This learn to skate program offered for skaters that are 5+ years old. It is coached by Professional Skate Canada coaches in a group lesson environment. Skaters will follow skill progression through stages/badges 1-6 as set out by Skate Canada programming. CSA approved hockey helmet and mittens are mandatory and a face mask is highly recommended. Skaters working on their stage 6 must wear a helmet on this session. **WEDNESDAY EVENING - 6:10 pm. (Program Ends Wed. Aug. 7th)**

Powerskating: This program focuses on specific skating skills for hockey & ringette players. Skaters should already be skating independently in a forward direction, attempting backwards skating and stopping. **WEDNESDAY EVENING - 7:10 pm**

CLUB POLICIES

Refunds - Are accepted prior to the first day of skating, less a \$35.00 administration fee. Medical reasons, with a doctor's certificate, and moves outside the region will be also be considered as per club policy. NO refunds or adjustments will be made due to holiday, illness, maintenance repairs or ice cancellations; however, the WFSC does pride itself in trying to accommodate family situations that are beyond control.

Test Days - Summer Test day is during the day on Wed. Aug. 14th 2019. In addition to Skate Canada test fees, there are ice and hospitality fees added to the skater's test sheet. ** Skaters wishing to test on Aug. 14th, 2019 must be registered for a minimum of 7 daytime on ice sessions or registered in a WFSC evening program to avoid a guest skating fee and the possibility of not being able to test if there is not room for registered members.

Non-Skating Days - There will be non skating dates throughout the season which are taken into account when determining pricing of the programs. Aug. 5th is a non-skating day.

Skater's Code of Conduct - All skaters participating in the Summer Skating School program are required to follow the Skaters' Code of Conduct throughout the season.
